- *Ensure payment information is up to date. Per our Parent Handbook, tuition is due prior to care and charged the Friday before the week begins. Debit card/credit card payments will incur a 3% processing fee per transaction. If you wish to avoid this fee, please update your account with checking account information (routing & account number) or request and ACH form.*

- Send along a family photo for the first day! It's comforting for children to see their loved ones.
- Expect some tears - from you and your child. If you will be leaving your precious little one for the first time, it can be emotional for everyone, so be prepared. introduce your child to the teacher and not feel rushed to get out the
- Ensure that we have all necessary supplies. Below is a list of supplies to bring according to your child's age:

Infants

- Diapers (Bring in bulk and we will let you know when more are needed)

- Wipes
- Diaper cream
- Bottles (labeled with name)
- Bibs
- Burp cloths
- Zip up sleeper sack for napping (no blankets for infants)
- Extra clothing sets (tags marked with your child's name in a labeled bag)
- Outdoor gear (hats, mittens, coats, etc.)
- Prescription Medications (in original packaging marked with the child's name-drop off in the office)

### Toddlers

- Pull-Ups (extra underwear once potty trained)
- Wipes
- Sippy Cup (labeled with your child's name)
- Blanket for Nap
- Extra clothing sets (tags marked with your child's name in a labeled bag)
- Outdoor gear (jacket, hat, gloves, mittens, boots, etc.)
- Prescription Medications (in original packaging marked with the child's name-drop off in the office)
- Sunscreen (labeled with your child's name)

### Preschoolers

- Water Bottle (labeled with your child's name)
- Blanket for Nap
- Extra clothing sets (tags marked with your child's name in a labeled bag)
